"The Lighthouse"

My favorite Christmas movie is *Scrooge*, the 1970 musical starring Albert Finney. My favorite scene involves my favorite song also. During the visit of the ghost of Christmas yet to come, the citizens start singing the song, "Thank You Very Much," in front of Scrooge's office. Scrooge thinks he has done some great service for the people and starts making a speech (of course, they cannot see or hear him). Unbeknownst to Scrooge, they are actually thanking him for dying, because all their debts (to him) are canceled. They parade down the street, even dancing on his coffin. That scene reminds me that we should be singing "thank you very much" to Jesus Christ for dying on the cross for us and

canceling our debts also, our debt of sin. The Apostle Paul wrote, "And when you were dead in trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, he made you alive with him and forgave us all our trespasses. He erased the certificate of debt, with its obligations, that was against us and opposed to us, and has taken it away by nailing it to the cross." (Colossians 2:13-14 CSB)

At the end of the movie Scrooge repents of his stinginess and claims he will "start anew" and "make amends." He decides to cancel all the debts owed to him by the town's people and they again sing, "Thanks You Very Much," in the grand finale. As Thanksgiving approaches, take time to tell the Heavenly Father "thank you very much" for canceling our debt to sin and giving us the gift of eternal life. Paul writes, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord," (Romans 6:23). And like Paul, let's be thankful of God's gift. "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!" (2 Corinthians 9:15). Happy Thanksgiving!
